



HIGH-RISE

HIGH-RISE stars Hiddleston as Dr. Robert Laing, the newest resident of a luxurious apartment in a high-tech concrete skyscraper whose lofty location places him amongst the upper class. Laing quickly settles into high society life and meets the building's eccentric tenants: Charlotte (Miller), his upstairs neighbor and bohemian single mother; Wilder (Evans), a charismatic documentarian who lives with his pregnant wife Helen (Moss); and Mr. Royal (Irons), the enigmatic

architect who designed the building. Life seems like paradise to the solitude-seeking Laing. But as power outages become more frequent and building flaws emerge, particularly on the lower floors, the regimented social strata begins to crumble and the building becomes a battlefield in a literal class war. HIGH-RISE is the latest film by cult British director Ben Wheatley (Kill List, A Field in England), an ambitious adaptation of the J.G. Ballard novel of the same name.






























AUTOMATED FARMING

s children, we used to think of a time when robots would enter our lives and would be used for industrial production. This thought will soon not be a thing of the future, since the first automated factory is set to be in operation in mid-2017, in Japan. The word is for a Vegetable Factory in which everything but the planting of seeds will be mechanically operated. Before we get too excited about this technological development let's take a minute and see what kind of effects that might have into our lives.

Let's start with the advantages of industrial robots. First of all, industrial automated robots perform applications with precision and high repeatability, every time. This consistency is hard to achieve in any other way. Also the production speed is higher with the use of industrial robots, because robots don't have the need to take a break, sleep or go on vacation, they have the ability to work at a constant speed without pausing. Another advantage of the industrial robots is the safety of the workers. Workers no longer have to move and perform dangerous tasks themselves, instead they operate the robots to do these tasks. And last but certainly not least, savings. By replacing humans with robots, factories have a huge amount of savings since keeping in it shape, a robot costs less than hiring a human to complete the same task. In addition, improved worker safety leads to financial savings with fewer healthcare and insurance concerns for employers.

Even though the idea of an automated factory seems to be pretty good, there are some disadvantages to it. The most important of them is the initial high cost. The investment that has to be made in order to purchase these robots for a factory are really high and demand an

already existing asset, which means that only factories who already have a lot of profit will be able to make more of it and that smaller companies should make an application for a loan taking a risk. Which leads us to the possibility that the robots don't give guaranteed results and the fund might go to waste or even worse, the company declares bankruptcy. But let's say that the fund is available, then the company has to hire staff who are able to control the robots. And so this leads to another problem: expertise. The employees will need to be trained in how they will program and interact with the robotic equipment. This requirement leaves the company with two options: one is the education of the employees who already work at the said factory and the other, hiring employees already educated. Both of these options will cost money to the company.

So, as we can see based on a quick research, an automated factory may seem to have more advantages than disadvantages. But the disadvantages seem to be more catastrophic if the ground isn't prepared well enough to make the technological changes. And so, we come to the conclusion that before thinking about making these changes and adding robots to a factory, a large fund is needed.

ermany has legalized prostitution since 2002. Under current laws, sex workers are now able to collect public unemployment insurance and medical coverage. Although condoms are really effective they are not perfect. Condoms can break, tear or slip off during use. Sometimes the couple may not be


aware the condom has torn while having intercourse. The Mayo Clinic states that two out of 100 condoms break. even ruin the mood.

Under the new proposed law, sex workers will not only have to use protection but they will also have to meet with health counselors to keep in track their sex health. That way, even if a sex worker gets offended by a sexual transmitted disease or infection, they will know and then get treated for it.

Whether you're a sex worker, a client of one or even a sexually active individual, your health is something that has to be taken seriously. By using protection you don't take a chance of becoming ill or offended by a sexual disease or infection that will afflict you possibly for the rest of your life. Safe sex is a lifestyle that should be adopted by everyone and the German government by approving this new law shows a good example and begins a battle to reduce sexual transmitted diseases and infections.



NEW WAYS TO TREAT DEPRESSION

In the recent news model Cara Delevingne has opened up about her battle with depression.

epression is one of the most crippling medical disorders. According to the American Psychiatric Association, depression afflicts one in 15 of the adult population and approximately one in six adults will go through depression at some point. These statistics also grow at an alarming rate year after year. Depression also dominantly affects women and people who are 45 vears old and above. Depression does not just the patient's

mental well-being, but it can also lead

to complications to the victim's physical health. Depression is also a prevalent condition among people who lack access to health insurance policies and those who suffer from sleeping disorders, obesity, heart conditions and stroke.

Feelings of Depression

A depressed patient goes through more than two weeks of loneliness and feelings of isolation. One also suffers from feelings of guilt and worthlessness and finds the once pleasurable activities uninteresting anymore. When a patient is gripped with severe depression, he also encounters suicidal

Not only does depression affect the

mind, but also the patient's physical well-being. A depressed patient loses his appetite, thus resulting to weight loss. The patient may also have trouble sleep or may sleep too much leading to feelings of extreme fatigue and restlessness. Headache and muscle pains are also common symptoms of depression.

Depression cripples both the mind and the body and it can have significant impact to the patient's over-all well-being to the point of not being able to function at home, at work and in the community. Moreover, severe depression can cause the patient to entertain the idea of a suicide, leading to his death.





Fortunately, depression is a treatable condition. A patient needs a holistic treatment approach, including but not limited to self-help, medications and therapies in order to beat depression.

Breakthrough Treatments for Depression

While traditional ways of treating depressions have shown success among patients, new and breakthrough treatments now promise significant success rates.

Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS)

TMS is a non-invasive procedure which involves sending magnetic fields to certain parts of the brain and eases the symptoms of depression. TMS is specifically recommended for patients with treatment-resistant major depressive disorder.

During the treatment, the physician places electromagnetic coils on the scalp corresponding to the parts of the brain where mood activities are located. Electromagnetic fields are then sent painlessly to these areas, which many patients describe as the "brain lighting up."

TMS has become a promising treatment particularly to patients who do not respond well to traditional depression treatments. The treatment also boasts of minimal side effects, including soreness of muscles, headaches and minor seizures. But in general, TMS is a safe

treatment that last for less than 30 minutes per session.

According to experts, delivering small doses of electromagnetic stimulation repeatedly to the brain is an effective way of combating depression and its symptoms. In 2014, 42 TMS clinics in different parts of the US were examined and the results revealed that 58% of the patients experienced significant improvement while 37% went full remission, according to the report of Depression and Anxiety in 2012.

But TMS can be an expensive option. The treatments can total to 20-30 sessions, and the patient can receive 3-5 treatments per week, lasting for a month and two weeks. In total, the cost of TMS can range between \$6,000-\$12,000.

• Low-Field Magnetic Stimulation

According to researchers of low-field magnetic stimulation (LFMS), physicist Michael Rohan, "LFMS is unlike any current treatment. It uses magnetic fields that are a fraction of the strength but at a higher frequency than the electromagnetic fields used in TMS [transcranial magnetic stimulation] and ECT [electroconvulsive therapy]."

Rohan is a lecturer in Harvard Medical School and works in McLean Hospital's Brain Imaging Center as a physicist. As the first author of said study, LFMS provides immediate effects and improvements in mood, a far cry to

traditional anti-depressants' effects that can take effect in a month or so. Also, unlike the conventional ECT, low magnetic fields with higher frequency that comes with LFMS have no side effects.

Rohan believes that this breakthrough can "provide relief in emergency situations." In his study, Rohan used portable tabletop LFMS device to examine the effects of said innovation to 63 volunteer patients. These patients have severe depression and bipolar disorder and have been taking anti-depressants for the past6 weeks. 34 of the volunteers received LFMS treatment while the remaining 29 did not.

Rohan observed that those who received the treatment experienced immediate mood boost while the 29 volunteers did not.

While low-field magnetic stimulation seems to be promising at this point, researchers believe that more studies are needed to ensure the efficacy of this treatment in addressing depression.

Ketamine Infusion

Ketamine was not originally used treatment for depression, rather as an anesthetic. However, it was more popular as a club drug that provides anti-depressant effects in a matter of hours. Ketamine may induce hallucinogenic effects, but experts believe that same effects can life-saver especially to depressed patients with suicidal thoughts.

Ketamine-infused treatments aren't FDA-approved yet, but a number of patients are already seeking off-label treatments. According to Kyle Lapidus, a psychiatrist from Stony Brook University, "the benefits I've seen are pretty impressive, and the data are very strong." Ketamine is seen as a remarkable depression treatment that can take effect in an hour or less with noticeably lesser to no side effects.

Meanwhile, psychiatrist Dr. David Fiefel from the University of California has provided Ketamine treatments to around 100 of his patients. He knows that doing so can put him at odds with other psychiatrists since Ketamine has been approved by FDA yet, but he also feels compelled to provide depression treatments that work, Ketamine being the case here. Dr. Feifel argues that Ketamine has proven to be an effective anesthetic over the years with the ability of blocking pain without

compromising the body's other vital functions.

Protein-targeted Studies for Depression Treatment

Experts from the University of Michigan in collaboration with Molecular & Behavioral Neuroscience Institute, found out that the protein FGF9 is higher in people with depression while people with no depression seems to have no excess of such protein. Elvse Aurbach, a neuroscience doctoral student at the University of Michigan believed that depressed people have 32% more of the FGF9 protein, but also saw the remarkably lesser amount of the protein FGF2.

Aurbach says that "depressed individuals can simultaneously have too little of some chemicals, like

serotonin, and too much of others, like FGF9. By identifying genes like FGF9 that are too high in depressed brains, we have the opportunity to determine if blocking their activity helps with the symptoms of depression."

From here, Aurbach believes that the next anti-depressants could now specifically target blocking the activities of FGF9. "We're working on many studies to better understand FGF9. We're

interested in how FGF9 levels change in depression for many brain regions and we're trying to understand if and how FGF9 interacts with other genes to have effects on mood," she continues.

Self-Help Strategies in Dealing with Depression

While studies on new depression treatments are under way, dealing with depression is still the best option for people who have it. While it may seem difficult for a patient to feel better when washed with bouts of depression, there are a number of coping mechanisms that can help in elevating their moods.

1.Know the difference between depression and sadness. It's easy to confuse depression and sadness, but





knowing the difference can lead to specific and effective treatment solutions. If you're constantly sad for long stretches of time, you are most likely depressed.

2.Surround yourself with positive people. Connect with people who give you support during your down moments can help pull you out from the pits of depression. Depression may urge you to wallow in isolation and you might

believe that being alone can provide you more comfort, but connecting with people you trust is a good way of lightening up your emotional loads.

3.Try to sleep better. Studies show that getting ample sleep help improve the mood and energy of a depressed patient. It is also not advisable to get too much sleep. To get you into routine sleeping, set an alarm and strive to sleep and rise on the same hours consistently.

4.Modify your diet. Your food intake can have profound impact to your mood. Instead of eating three huge meals, divide them into four-six smaller ones. This can help stabilize your blood sugar. Also consider switching out refined carbs and add more fruits and vegetables into your meals. Take vitamins like omega 3 and

watch your alcohol and caffeine consumption.

Depressed people feel like they're in a cold, dark place but the new treatments and technological breakthroughs provide promise of breaking through from this pit of darkness. Coupled with other techniques like therapy, support from friends and family and self-help coping strategies, it really is possible to break free from the grasps of depression.





Can you please tell the readers a little about your style of art?



Did you ever go to an art school or did it come naturally to you?


I suppose because I was drawing and painting from birth I didn't need to!

REMEMBERING DAVID BOWIE: THE MAN AND LEGEND


hen it comes to David Bowie there is no dichotomy between David Bowie the man and David Bowie the legend. The genuinely intriguing and ever evolving creature, nothing short of a musical genius, can not be reduced to Bowie the man and the Bowie of the stage. He lived through his art, whole-heartedly exploring the new and the unknown through his personas, personas that were never just a facade.

His death affected not only a following

of dedicated fans, it devastated the entire world. It seemed to come as a shock that we could have a world without Bowie. Because how could a man who came from out of space succumb to death like a mere mortal? His departure from our time and space left the world in mourning, Bowie had genuinely been important to millions across the globe. This was more than the loss of a superstar, it was the loss of a true visionary who had unarquably moulded the world in which we live in.

Forceful lyricist, crusader of sexuality and artistic chameleon are just some of the ways that are fitting in describing one who was born in Brixton and named David Jones. From the beginning it was more than the colour of his eyes that was odd about him. But Bowie was never afraid of embracing the odd, propelling the unusual and elevating the different. At age 17 his strength in his convictions was already clear when he was interviewed about his newly formed Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Long-Haired men. For a man it seemed lived as dozens of different selves, he clearly had a strong sense of self from an early age. During his early years Bowie had

continually shown an interest in music.

He learned to play the saxophone and was introduced to beat literature and rock music through his older brother Terry, whom he looked up to. As a teenager Bowie played in several bands, most notably he fronted his

own band 'Davy Jones and the lower third'. Although his time with this band was marked with the release of several singles their music didn't manage to stir enough commercial attention. Following The Monkee's rise to fame, David opted to change his name from Jones to Bowie to avoid confusion with himself and the Davy Jones of The Monkees. Bowie released a solo album under his new identity, the first of many, but this wasn't the breakthrough he needed. The ever curious Bowie with his insatiable sense of urgency spent the next few years as part of the mime troupe called 'Feathers' as well landed to earth, or so it seemed in 1969. But you'd be forgiven for believing he was from another era entirely, futurist in his sound and look Ziggy captured the imagination of a generation. Bowie's distance from reality and vision into the future gave him prophet like status, something that continued throughout his entire career. Ziggy's etherial presence was completely captivating, but what cemented his place in the hearts of a generation was his ability that with all his oddness he still remained relevant. While his look was magical and alien, his lyrics were potent, unapologetic, witty and kids who heard them instantly felt an affinity to Bowie. An affinity to be felt for his entire career. Throughout his ever morphing faces and flirtations with new styles of music, Bowie never lost touch with his audience. In fact the only aspect of Bowie that was unchanging was this ability to maintain his relevance.

Bowie's personal and musical evolution was always one step ahead. As an artist you could sense his eagerness to push forward and explore. His curiosity was untiring. From Ziggy Stardust Bowie morphed into other alter-egos such as Aladdin Sane, The Thin White Duke, and Pierrot. Bowie continued to reinvent himself throughout his career, and even when he seemed to get it wrong he got it right. The universally unpopular Tin Machine, a band Bowie fronted in the late 80's, is said to have been the catalyst for the 90's grunge era. Without knowing it, yet another generation were being influenced by a musical revolution that again had it's roots with Bowie. The 90's was witness to a totally different Bowie both creatively and visually. In this era he embraced the persona of the outsider, and while this era is often his less well remembered it still has value musically. In this period Bowie was creating some truly experimental music, and again he was ahead of the game, exploring the virtues of drum and bass music years before the movement gained popularity with the masses.

Retrospectively it seemed that Bowie had the ability not only to influence the future by paving the way in fashion and music, but also to see into the future. Perhaps he truly was a man who came from out of space, his sense for what was to come was eerie. One night in 1989 will be remembered in the hearts of thousands who witnessed it. Years of heartache and separation finally came to a climatic end when the Berlin wall was torn down between East and West Berlin. Friends and family became reunited after 3 decades of separation, and it happened to the what is arguably Bowie's most popular song, Heroes. The song can still bring tears to the eyes of thousands who were there, it fitted the occasion

perfectly, as though it had been written for it as a film score suits a film. But the song was originally released in 1977, 12 years previous. Did Bowie have a sense of what was to come? Posthumously Bowie was thanked for his role in helping to bring down the wall by the German government. A sign that his time spent in Berlin will not soon be forgotten in the hearts of those who live there.

In 1981 Bowie released Under Pressure, the lyrics to which depict the homeless epidemic in the USA before it had even begun. It's not difficult to speculate that The Man Who Fell to Earth may have possessed superhuman powers, that time did not confine him. However, distill the intrigue and mystery from the man and perhaps we are left with an incredibly clever and intuitive human being who witnessed the world that we live in with such clarity that he sensed things to come.

It's difficult to remember David Bowie

by only recalling his musical success, he was a man of multiple talents, and he was not limited to success in only one. Just as he appeared to fall to earth as Ziggy Stardust, David once more was reborn and fell to Earth a second time. As a man who could never stand still, by the mid 70's Bowie had tired of rock and roll and sought to quench his creative thirst through acting. Bowie landed the lead role in Nicolas Roeg's film adaptation of Walter Trevis's novel, The Man Who Fell to Earth. Now a cult classic the film it was Bowie's breakthrough into the world of film, and the role couldn't have been more suited to him. An alien who crash lands on earth, with his own planet facing drought he is in search of water. Using futuristic alien technology he becomes an inventor in order to make money to enable him to return to his doomed planet. Bowie's endeavours in film continued, arguably his most memorable performance was as Jareth the Goblin King in the magical and at times rather unsettling Labyrinth.
